### Factors we considered when evaluating a player:

### •Productivity:

#### •Skills:

Does the player demonstrate the core skills, speed and strength necessary to be effective at that level?

#### •Coach-ability:

Does the player listen and respond to coaching instructions? Does the player value feedback? Does the player willingly make sacrifices based on the coach's instruction?

### •Character:

Does the player behave, communicate and respond in ways that contribute to team success?

### •Hockey Sense:

Does the player make choices that are consistent with winning hockey at that level?

#### •History:

Has the player historically performed at a level equivalent to the team's projected playing level and the team's players?

# •Team Roster Balance:

Does the player provide unique qualities the team needs in order to succeed against any opponent's playing style?
